INTERLIBRARY LOAN POLICY

The Greenville Public Library is a member of the Ocean State Library Consortium. An Ocean State Library card provided by the Greenville Public Library will allow you to borrow materials from any other library that is a member of the OSL Consortium.

The Greenville Public Library allows Rhode Island Library users to borrow materials from Non-OSL Rhode Island libraries and out of state libraries using the Interlibrary Loan Service. This service is governed under the Library of Rhode Island Standards, and managed by the Office of Library and Information Services (OLIS). Materials requested via Interlibrary loan will be subject to the lending policies of the owning library. Materials can be requested through ILL at the Greenville Public Library by the Reference Department staff. There is no charge for ordering materials through ILL, but there is a return postage charge of \$3.00. All materials are subject to fines and fees established by the Greenville Public Library.

The Greenville Public Library participates in resource sharing of all circulating materials, with the exception of non-reservable materials, equipment and special collections.
